These brief documents offer fresh perspectives on strategic issues related to North American defence, Arctic security, and implications of major power competition for Canada and its allies.

- Longer reports (6+ pages) and should contain a short executive summary up-front (or separate synopsis document) to make them more accessible to a “skimming/scanning” audience
- Single-spaced
- Numerical endnotes as required

Policy Briefs:

Short briefings that provide information, succinct analysis, and policy suggestions on specific topics for policy-making and expert audiences.

- 2-4 pages
- Although NAADSN does not prescribe to a fixed format, these papers should begin with a short summary box and should include the following elements:
 - Issue (one or two bullets at the onset)
 - Background
 - Options and/or Suggestions
- Single-spaced
- Numerical endnotes as required

NAADSN Policy Primers offer overviews on a specific topic to serve as foundations for further research and/or policy development.

- Longer reports (6+ pages) and should contain a short executive summary up-front (or separate synopsis document) to make them more accessible to a “skimming/scanning” audience
- Single-spaced
- Numerical endnotes as required
